Motion by Egnoire to approve the agenda as presented. Seconded by Fett. Motion carried unanimously.

Communications

- A. Visitors - None
- B. Board Communication – Mindy Donovan has been contacted by several patrons regarding access to Wi-Fi, the number of lunches being served vs. the number of free and reduced students and some seniors not hearing from counselors or teachers. There is free Wi-Fi at North Park by the pool and by the Community Building for students to access, no password needed. Mr. Amos will put this information out through social media. Lunches provided are averaging about 130/week now but this is less than the number of students who qualify for free/reduced meals. Calls have been made to some families to make sure they know about the program. Emails going out are coming from a no reply email address. This is because the emails are generated through Infinite Campus. It was suggested that the teacher sign and add their email address at the end to make it easier for students/parents to respond. Mr. Amos will mention this at the District leadership meeting on Tuesday.

Updates/Information

- A. Update on District Crisis Response Plan for March 16 – May 22 Closure Period
The crisis response plan has been updated to extend through May 22 due to the governor's closure of school until the end of the year.
- B. Continuous Learning Plan – High School Credit Course Adjustment April 27-May 22
There will be an adjustment to the plan for high school credit courses. March 12 will be the final day to be used for grades. The high school students along with 8th graders taking high school courses will have three options: 1) take the grade for the course as of March 12 for the final grade; 2) take the course pass/fail if the student has a 60% in the course as of March 12; 3) try to improve the grade by retaking any assessments given from the start of the second semester and the opportunity to turn in late work. Students will work with

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their teachers to create a plan. These options do not apply to DMACC concurrent courses as they are being completed online. The timeline is as follows: Apr. 21-23 – students are to select an option via district survey. Parents and students will receive the email about the survey. Students can choose which option they want to do for each course. If no option is chosen, the grade as of March 12 will stand. April 24 – staff members will be contacting students who didn't respond to the survey. April 27-May 3 – students who chose option 3 will work with teachers to raise their grade. May 27 – final grades will be posted for all students. Mr. Amos went over FAQ's regarding the plan.

Business/Action Items

A. Approval of School Board Resolution April 20 – Pandemic Response and Emergency Suspension of Policy This is an extension of the original plan. Hourly employees will get paid through May 22.

B. Approval of Extension of District Crisis Response Plans to May 22nd

The original plan has been extended to the end of the school year, May 22.

C. Approval of High School Credit Course Adjustment to Continuous Learning Plan

Motion by Eginoire to approve the high school credit course adjustment to continuous learning plan.

The April 27 meeting will address several issues such as returning to school next fall, high school graduation and how students can get into school to get their stuff.
