PUBLIC HEARING

A. Sale of Property, 200 School Street, Carlisle, IA

The public hearing started at 6:00 p.m. The public hearing was for the sale of property at 200 School St. No public comments were received or noted. The public hearing ended at 6:01 p.m.

A. Resolution for the Sale of Property

One offer was received for the sale and removal of the house at 200 School Street. The offer was from Gary Witt for \$12,000. Mr. Amos is recommending to approve the sale.

B. District Mitigation for Summer 2021 Activities & Programs

Mr. Amos introduced proposed mitigation efforts for summer activities and programs at the last regular board meeting. Then updates were received from the state. Mr. Amos is proposing that masks are recommended/optional on buses and suburbans, at events and within buildings this summer. The District will still maintain the other mitigation strategies that have been in place. As far as wearing masks on school transportation vehicles, in January there was an executive order from the president for masks to be worn on public transportation. In February, the CDC stated that school buses were a part of public transportation but the executive order didn't specify school buses. Therefore the Dept. of Education said the Districts were left to determine what they would do. As far as the fall, this will be a discussion during June and July as the District has to submit another return to learn plan for ESSER funding.
